Bylaw No. 145

A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF SILVER BEACH TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION, CONTROL AND OPERATION OF PUBLIC RESERVES

WHEREAS by virtue of the power conferred upon it by the *Municipal Government Act*, Chapter M-26, R.S.A. 1980, and amendments thereto, the Council of the Summer Village of Silver Beach in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw shall be known as the "Parks Bylaw".
- 2. Definitions
 - (a) "Park" means any public park, public reserve or reserve under the control and management of the Summer Village of Silver Beach.
 - (b) "Ouimette Park" means Lot R, Block 1, Plan 4107 EO and Lot P, Block 1, Plan 4107 EO.
- 3. Regulations
 - (a) Overnight camping in any park is prohibited.
 - (b) Parking of any vehicle or recreational vehicles, campers, trailers, and the like in any park is prohibited.
 - (c) Open fires in any park are prohibited.
 - (d) Any uses that are deemed to be obnoxious, a nuisance or prejudicial to the peace, quiet and enjoyment of residents and visitors are prohibited.
 - (e) Dogs are not permitted on or in any park.
 - (f) Ouimette Park is designated as a day use are and the hours of use shall be from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. each day.

4. Penalties

(a) Any person who commits a breach of any of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to a voluntary penalty of \$25.00 for each and every offence and in the event of non-payment of the voluntary penalty shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than \$2,500.00 and not less than \$100.00 and in default of payment to imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days.

The Summer Village of Silver Beach Bylaw No. 78 is hereby repealed upon this Bylaw coming into effect.
