



**A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF SILVER BEACH TO AUTHORIZE
THE CONSOLIDATION OF BYLAWS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of section 69 of the MGA (as defined below), the Council may pass a bylaw to authorize a designated officer to consolidate bylaws.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council (as defined below), duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

- 1.1 This Bylaw shall be known as the "Consolidation Bylaw".

2. DEFINITIONS

- 2.1 Definitions used in this Bylaw, if not defined in this Bylaw, shall have the same meanings attributed to those definitions in the MGA.
- 2.2 In this Bylaw:
- a) **"Chief Administrative Officer"** means the Chief Administrative Officer for the Summer Village;
 - b) **"Council"** means the Council of the Summer Village;
 - c) **"MGA"** means the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26; and
 - d) **"Summer Village"** means the Summer Village of Silver Beach.

3. GENERAL INTERPRETATION

- 3.1 Headings or subheadings in this Bylaw are inserted for ease of reference and guidance purposes only and do not form part of this Bylaw.
- 3.2 Words in the singular include the plural and words in the plural include the singular.
- 3.3 Where this Bylaw cites or refers to any act, regulation, code or other bylaw, the citation or reference to the act, regulation, code or other bylaw includes any amendments thereto before or after the commencement of this Bylaw, and includes reference to any act, regulation, code or other bylaw that may be substituted in its place.



- 3.4 Each provision of this Bylaw is independent of, and severable from, all other provisions and if any provision is declared invalid or unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, all other provisions of this Bylaw remain valid and enforceable.
- 3.5 Nothing in this Bylaw relieves a person from complying with any provision of any federal, provincial or municipal law or regulation or any requirement of any lawful permit, order or license.

4. CONSOLIDATION

- 4.1 That the Chief Administrative Officer be authorized to consolidate such bylaws of the Summer Village as may be amended, in accordance with the Municipal Government Act.

5. COMING INTO FORCE

- 6.1 This Bylaw shall become effective when it has received third and final reading and has been signed by the Mayor and the Chief Administrative Officer.

READ a first time this 29th day of September, 2025.

READ a second time this 29th day of September, 2025.

UNANIMOUS CONSENT to proceed to third reading this 29th day of September, 2025.

READ a third and final time this 29th day of September, 2025.
